

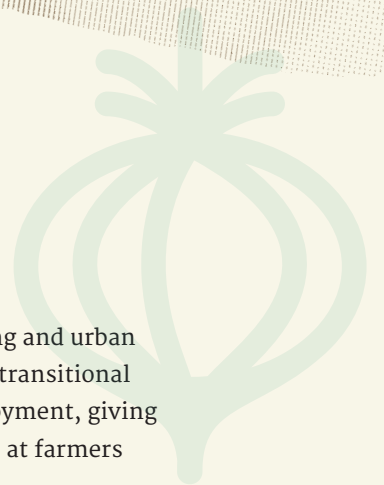


GROWING HOME

Growing Home builds healthy people and communities through job training and urban agriculture. Our award-winning program uses organic farming to provide transitional employment and job readiness training to individuals with barriers to employment, giving them the opportunity to secure full-time, stable jobs. Our produce is sold at farmers markets around the city, and on-site at our Englewood farm.

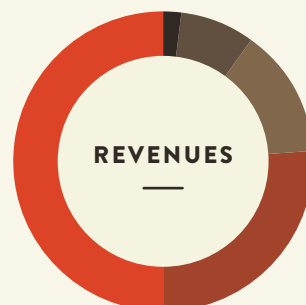
