FARM UPDATES

Growing Home's Englewood Farm Stand is back! Come by and stock up on nutritious, locally grown food straight from the farm to your table! Despite a cool May with some brief spikes into the high 80's, our plantings have remained on schedule. The earliest plantings of greens, salad mixes, and root vegetables have already been harvested for our farmers markets and partner pantries. With wholesale deliveries waiting and home delivery programs on the horizon in June, we've wasted no time flipping our earliest plantings for new sets of transplants and seeds which will keep the farm lush with produce in August.



DERRICK ROSE GARDEN UPDATE

Beyond just growing food, we're filling our space with some new beauty. Through our collaboration with the Derrick Rose Foundation and the Chicago Bulls, we've revitalized the front garden on Wood St. To encourage the welcoming opportunities at Growing Home, we've removed the fence surrounding the garden, added a border wall, and added soil during Englewood Unity Day. In dedication of Derrick Rose, we've planted several varieties of shrub and climbing roses along with dozens of native flower plants and grasses to support native pollinators.

been placed in employment.
